By redefining the role of the arts in a time of social change and the climate emergency, Ocean Space's educational programming aims to engage the teaching community at all levels, along with students and their families, on issues relating to pressing worldwide social and environmental challenges.

Ocean Space offers targeted educational paths towards sustainability, through pragmatic activities and the promotion of best practices, encouraging collective reflection, critical thinking and conscious action in the name of the environment. Ocean Space intends to start a permanent educational program that allows everyone to feel like an active participant, and offer a solid contribution to the protection of our planet.

If we know so little about the ocean, and its role in the health of our planet, how are we supposed to properly care for it or understand the urgency for change?

During the presentation, topics relating to citizenship education, sustainability, oceanographic issues, and contemporary culture will be introduced, and best educational practices and hands-on strategies for a new, transformative vision will be shared.

OBJECTIVES

- To create a community of teachers and students that can grow together with Ocean Space
- To create and share ecological awareness to improve the environment through a multidisciplinary approach, and initiate a lifelong learning process
- To co-operate and plan together, discussing what the needs and requirements for knowledge are, through continuous comparison and feedback from students
- To initiate courses in two disciplinary areas: in science and technology, and in the humanities
